



HOW TO ADD A PROJECT ON RAVELRY

Go to the Projects drop down (under “my notebook” heading tab on the main page in the upper right)



Click on ADD A PROJECT (in the upper left)



NAME: Type in you're the name you'd like to give your project (for example: Snowflake Sweater for Melissa or Red Snowflake Sweater) or you can just use the exact pattern name; if you make more than one it's nice to label them by color or number: Fiber Friends Shawl #2 white

PATTERN NAME: Type in Pattern Name (Snowflake Sweater)

Click CONTINUE

Choose one of the projects that pops up and click on CHOOSE THIS PATTERN

Fill in the boxes: (I think these are most important)

SIZE

TAGS

NEEDLE (this is a drop down box, just click and drag) you can use more than one

YARN (you can click from your stash if you've already got it listed, otherwise type it in and then a drop down will pop up) after typing click the little chain link

NOTES: absolutely anything is pertinent; you'd be surprised at what you're so happy you

remembered to put here, when you come back 6 months from now and CRS

DATE STARTED (a calendar will pop up, just click near Started)

CLICK SAVE CHANGES in bottom right hand of page!

Post a Photo

Click on Add Photos at the top of the project page

Click Choose Files (this is a drop down box, choose where you're going to get your photo from: computer, (phone if you're using it) stash, Instagram, Google, Flickr, URL) drop it or drag it to the outlined box. If you're using your phone or ipad, you have the option to just take the photo right then which I find really convenient. Click on Take photo or video

Choose your photo by scrolling through to the one you need, click on it, sometimes then you have to click open or done on this page

Click Upload Now

Click Finished with Photos

HOW TO ADD TO STASH ON RAVELRY

Go to the Stash drop down under your notebook heading tab on the main page

Click ADD TO STASH

Type in:

Where purchased

Name of Yarn base (this is what the company calls this particular weight of their yarn, it can just be worsted or DK but sometimes it's things like Soliloquy, or Box Office or Fancy Fingering, different companies have names for their different bases like MCN called one thing and MCS called another so they can differentiate) it should be clearly written on your label

Yarn Company or brand

Store name

Click CONTINUE

Click on the yarn that matches yours CHOOSE THIS YARN

Fill in the Boxes:

Colorway and closest color

Color attributes is new

How many skeins?

Dyelot if applicable (indie dyed yarns won't have this)

Notes: "Got this on Sale" "for my Birthday" "to be a Friendship Road Hat" Typing in what the project might be is really helpful when you inevitably forgot why you bought this yarn

Click Save Stash!

Post a Photo

Click on Add Photos at the top of the page

Click Choose Files (this is a drop down box, choose where you're going to get your photo from: computer, (phone if you're using it) stash, Instagram, Google, Flickr, URL)
